

Porcelain Veneers (Lumineers)

Congratulations on your new smile! These restorations were placed with the finest materials and techniques available today. With proper continuing care & follow up, we expect that you will receive many years of service from your new veneers.

Chewing

- Remember that it may take time to adjust to the feel of your new bite or the way your teeth fit together
- Don't be concerned if your speech is affected for the first few days. You'll quickly adapt and be speaking normally.
- You may notice increased salivation. This should also be back to normal in about a week.
- Don't chew on ice, pencils, finger nails and excessively hard foods such as hard candy, popcorn hulls, bones, etc..
- **Never** bite off carrot sticks, pretzels, apples, etc. with your front teeth

Sensitivity

- It is normal to experience some hot & cold sensitivity. Your gums may also be sore for a few days. A mild pain medication (Tylenol or Ibuprofen) should ease any discomfort.

Oral Hygiene

- As with your natural teeth, veneers require good oral hygiene. Always brush with an ultra soft toothbrush. Floss between all teeth at least once a day. Always use non-abrasive, fluoride toothpaste
- We will examine and polish your veneers at your regular check up & cleaning visit. Often problems that are developing around the veneers can be found at an early stage and repaired easily.

Protection

- If you grind or clench your teeth, you may need to have a night guard made to minimize the stress that you place on your teeth. This will lengthen the life of your veneers.
- If you engage in sports, let us know so we can make a custom mouthguard.
